## Fall Orthopedic Report

The Fall Children's Orthopedic Clinic, sponsored by Des Plaines Elks Lodge was held on November 6, 2008 at the Northwest Orthopedic Surgery office in Arlington Heights.

Although announcements were sent to newspapers and schools, the response was very low. Only four appointments were made and one was a no-show.

Of those patients attended to by Dr. Marty and his staff: an eleven-year-old boy and a six-year-old girl who had flat feet and were in need of pre-fabricated arch supports. A five-year-old girl was given a prescription for bi-lateral splints and molded arch supports. We may need to help with funding for this child. X-rays were not required at this time.

We continue to be grateful to Dr. Marty and his staff for helping us provide this service.

The 2009 schedule is being finalized at this time. The Winter Clinic will be held in early February. Efforts are being made to resolve any problems with our communications process in making the public aware of our clinics. ❁

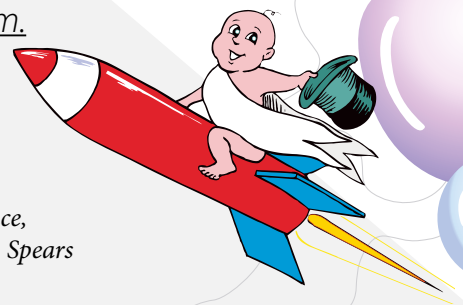

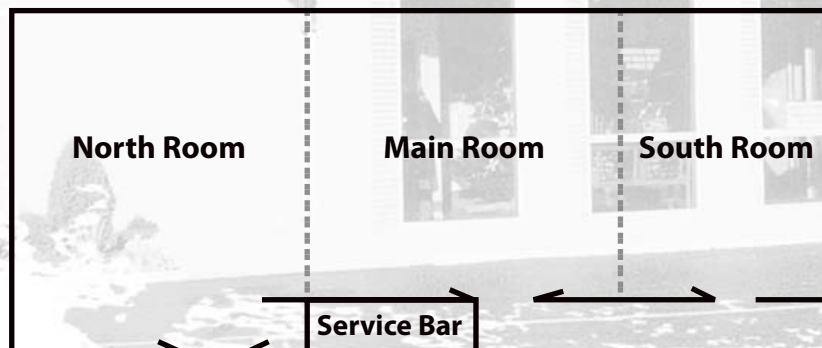

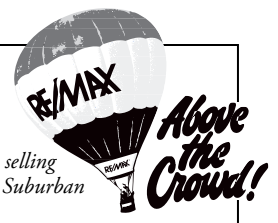
